

# Promoting Healthy Independence



Care Resources is a Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE®), a community-based program for people 55 years or older that promotes healthy, independent living and helps prevent nursing home placement.

Funded by Medicare and Medicaid, there are no or very limited out-of-pocket expenses for eligible participants.\* A private pay option is also available.

The PACE model with our expanded services allows Care Resources to remain both operational and successful in times of community crisis. From the pandemic to severe weather and even through the many challenges associated with rising healthcare costs and accessibility, Care Resources has been able to quickly adapt to new, innovative ways of supporting, protecting, and treating our participants.

## Care Resources PACE eligibility:

- 55 years or older

## Care Resources Comprehensive Care Model



Clinical care and prescription medications provided per individual treatment plans



Telehealth, telemonitoring, and home care services incorporated as appropriate



Social services support via calls, visits, and onsite interactions



Meals delivered to participants' homes or provided at the Day Center



Grocery shopping provided for participants when needed



Transportation to and from Care Resources and approved medical appointments



Physical, occupational, speech, and recreational therapy
