A team approach to care

Our Care Resources team of healthcare professionals works with you and your family to develop a comprehensive care plan—helping you make medical decisions every step of the way. Care is delivered at our full-service Primary Care Clinic, our adult Day Center, and through a network of community providers.

Our Care Resources team includes physicians, nurses, social workers, dieticians, therapists (physical, occupational, and recreational), home care coordinators, and other staff.

For most who qualify, there are no premiums, deductibles, or co-pays for any service (unless a person goes into a nursing home for more than 30 days).

Services must be pre-approved. Not all people in PACE receive all these services.

- 55 years or older

- Able to live safely in the community when you join PACE
- Meet the State of Michigan nursing facility level of care
