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The Interdisciplinary Team (IDT)

IDT is the core decision-making body at Care Resources PACE. IDT is composed of the following teams:

- Primary Care Providers and Nurses Coordinate all medical care for each participant
- Social Workers Enhance participant well-being and coordinate benefits
- Participant Care Assistants Provide various care services necessary for attending to the personal needs, support, and health of participants
- Home Care Nurses Evaluate home safety and coordinate home care hours
- Physical & Occupational Therapists Assist participants with daily living as well as strength and mobility
- **Dietitians** Oversee all aspects of nutritional health
- Pharmacy Staff Work with participants, families, and physicians to ensure medications are up-to-date and taken properly
- Activity Staff & Recreational Therapy Schedule and coordinate programs and activities at the Day Center and at home
- Transportation Staff Schedule and provide transportation

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Boosting Community Health

Vaccine Updates: COVID-19, Influenza, and RSV

We work hard to provide a safe and healthy environment for all of our participants and staff. We continue to offer the most current vaccines recommended for seniors; including the 2024/2025 COVID-19 vaccine. This booster protects against the most common strain of COVID-19. We started vaccinating in October and plan to offer vaccines to all of our participants before the end of the year.

We also encourage participants and staff to get their annual flu shot. We offer the flu vaccine to all new and current participants who are eligible. We'll continue to provide it through the end of the flu season in March.

Additionally, we continue to offer the RSV vaccine. This vaccine protects against severe respiratory disease. RSV is a onetime dose given to those who are eligible and haven't received it yet.

As a reminder, if you can't make it to Care Resources PACE for your vaccines, you may stop by a pharmacy that gives them. If you receive a vaccine or booster from a pharmacy, please let us know so we can keep track. If you have any questions, please ask one of our team members. We look forward to keeping everyone healthy during the winter months ahead!


